The first day of Kindergarten 2019

On the morning of Monday 4 February 2019 you are invited to arrive at the school from 8:45am. Please take your child directly to the kindergarten rooms to meet their teacher.

Turner School staff will assist you and there will be signs and maps directing you to the right classroom. After meeting the teacher and settling your child there will be a welcome morning tea held for parents in the school hall from 9:15am.



Parents need to indicate to the teacher on the first day the arrangements for collecting children at 3:00pm, particularly for week 1.

Kindergarten children attend school for the same hours as other classes—9:00am-3:00pm. For the first few weeks we always adopt a flexible approach, which allows parents to take tired children home early. Please discuss your child's needs with their teacher.

Stationery Pack Delivery



Preordered stationery packs will be delivered to school at the start of the year. They will be delivered straight to classes.

Order forms will be distributed prior to the end of 2017.

Preparing for Kindergarten

To ensure a smooth and happy transition to Kindergarten, it is helpful if children can already manage most of the following:

- Put on shoes and socks
- Manage the fastenings on any clothes
- Unscrew tops on drink bottles and open food containers
- Use the toilet and be aware of the need for personal hygiene and can wash hands independently
- Recognise own belongings (having all things named is important)
- Recognise own name
- Pack away materials after use.
