From Monday 23 September we are collecting QUALITY donations for the Fete !!

From 8.30am to 9am Monday 23 September, we start collecting every School Day morning up until Wednesday 23 October. Donations can be dropped into Room D18 (via the David St Office).

What we are collecting:

Quality second-hand items:

- Books, magazines, DVDs, CDs
- Toys, games, puzzles
- Clothes (for all ages and sizes), including hats, shoes, dress ups
- Sports good and jerseys (of all codes)
- Teddy bears and any soft toy that needs a new home

Note: If you have a bike/ scooter to donate, please contact turnerprimarypandc@gmail.com to ensure they are collected on the same day, or an alternate arrangement can be made to suit you, the School does not have the space for storing larger items, such as bikes.

Please try to bag your donations according to stall to make sorting easier.
Any sharp or potentially dangerous items should be left with the David St office staff.

What we are NOT collecting:

Please respect the guidelines below and DO NOT drop off any of the following:

- Clothing (or anything else) that is stained, dirty, damaged, or worn out socks, undies or bras.
- VHS video cassettes or computer books computers or computer monitors TVs mattresses or other large furniture
- No general household items (*there is **NO White Elephant Stall this year***).
